THE COWRA REGIONAL ART GALLERY INVITES ARTISTS WHO RESIDE IN AUSTRALIA TO SUBMIT ENTRIES FOR SELECTION INTO THE 2011 CALLEEN ART AWARD AND 2011 CENTRAL WEST REGIONAL ARTISTS AWARD.

THE CALLEEN ART AWARD

The Calleen Art Award is a nationally recognised annual acquisitive award for an original artwork in any painting medium including oils, acrylic, watercolour or mixed media (only if paint remains the dominant medium) and any style and subject. The Calleen Art Award was established in 1977 by Patricia Fagan OAM and is made possible by the generous support of the Calleen Trust.

THE CENTRAL WEST REGIONAL ARTISTS AWARD

The Central West Regional Artists Award was established in 2009 by the Cowra Regional Art Gallery in partnership with the generous support of a private donor. It is a non-acquisitive award for an original work in i) any painting medium including oils, acrylic, watercolour or mixed media (only if paint remains the dominant medium), or ii) any drawing medium on paper, and any style and subject. The award is open to artists living and working in the Central West Region of NSW as defined by the local government areas of Bathurst, Blayney, Cabonne, Cowra, Forbes, Lachlan, Lithgow, Mudgee/Gulgong (Mid Western Region), Oberon, Orange, Parkes, Weddin and Wellington. The winner of this award will also receive the opportunity of an exhibition at the Cowra Regional Art Gallery during 2012/2013.

PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD

The People's Choice Award is a non-acquisitive award presented to an artwork on display in the Gallery during the finalist's exhibition with the most votes submitted by visitors to the Gallery. This award has been made possible with the generous support of the Cowra Regional Art Gallery Friends Committee.

A. GENERAL INFORMATION

A1. SELECTION OF AWARD FINALISTS

- A1.1** Entrants must submit a CD with image/s of their work with an entry form. A Selection Panel (appointed by the Cowra Regional Art Gallery) will view the CDs to recommend a short list of finalists for exhibition. Please refer to the **Conditions of Entry** for more information.
- A1.2** An artist who lives and works in the local government areas of Bathurst, Blayney, Cabonne, Cowra, Forbes, Lachlan, Lithgow, Mudgee/Gulgong (Mid Western Region), Oberon, Orange, Parkes, Weddin and Wellington may enter a painting under the terms and conditions of entry into the Calleen Art Award and have the same work considered as a finalist in the Central West Regional Artists Award by ticking the box as set out in the Entry Form.
- A1.3** Exhibition of works shall be at the absolute discretion of the Cowra Regional Art Gallery which reserves the right to exhibit or not exhibit any work recommended by the **Selection Panel**. Also, no reason will be given, or communication entered into by the Gallery, its staff or its agents with regard to the selection of the short list of finalists for exhibition or the Judge's recommendations.

A2. ANNOUNCEMENT OF AWARD WINNERS

The selected finalists will be exhibited at the Cowra Regional Art Gallery from Saturday 16 April to Sunday 29 May 2011. The winners of the 2011 Calleen Art Award and 2011 Central West Regional Artists Award will be announced at the exhibition opening on **Friday 15 April 2011** by the Award's Judge. The winner of the People's Choice Award will be announced at the end of the exhibition.

B. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

B1. ELIGIBILITY

- B1.1** Entry into the **Calleen Art Award** is open to artists over 18 years, living and working in Australia. Entries must be an original artwork in a painting medium including oils, acrylic, watercolour or collage (only if paint remains the dominant medium). Entrants agree that in the event that their work is selected by the awards Judge as the winner of the 2011 Calleen Art Award and on payment of the award, the said work shall become the property of the Cowra Regional Art Gallery and part of the Calleen Collection.
- B1.2** Entry into the **Central West Regional Artists Award** is open to artists over 18 years, living and working in Central West NSW as set out in Section A1.2 of this entry form. Entries must be an original work in i) a painting medium including oils, acrylic, watercolour or mixed media (only if paint remains the dominant medium), or ii) any drawing medium on paper.
- B1.3** An artist or their authorised agent/dealer may enter up to 3 artworks in total as set out on the Entry Form, however, only one work per artist will be considered by the **Selection Panel** for exhibition. Entries must be the original work and concept of the entrant and completed in the 12 months prior to 2011. Works previously exhibited at the Cowra Regional Art Gallery are not eligible.
- B1.4** A non-refundable fee of \$33.00 (incl. GST) is payable with each work entered. A work entered without payment of an entry fee will not be considered eligible. Payment can be made as a cheque or money order made payable to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery or by credit card.
- B1.5** Entrants must submit high quality digital image/s of an entered artwork as a jpg file at 300dpi resolution and 2-5 megabytes file size on a CD accompanied by a completed Entry Form and entry fee payment for each entry (maximum 3 entries) - please include on each jpg image submitted text with the artist's name/title of the work. All entries including CDs will be retained for the Gallery archives.
- B1.6** A correctly completed and signed Entry Form accepting the entry conditions with entry fee payment and CD of images as an attachment must be received by the Cowra Regional Art Gallery at 77 Darling Street Cowra NSW 2794 **by 5pm on Saturday 5 March 2011**. Entries received after this date will not be eligible. All expenses and postage costs of an entry are the responsibility of the entrant. Neither, the Cowra Regional Art Gallery, its staff, or agents, and the Cowra Shire Council will be responsible for the loss or damage of an awards entry form and/or support CD information.
- B1.7** There is no restriction in size, however the maximum weight of an entry is 40kg.
- B1.8** The work must not be owned by a third party and the entry form must be signed by the artist as the owner of the work. The Gallery will contact the artist in the first instance in all matters relating to an entry.
- B1.9** An artist who has a work selected for inclusion in the finalist exhibition will be notified of the selection by phone and/or email immediately after the selection process is completed. **Note:** substitutes for a selected artwork will not be accepted.
- B1.10** By completing the entry form and making the work available the entrant warrants that the work is the sole and unencumbered property of entrant and that there is no inhibition or restriction upon title passing to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery in the event that the work is the winning entry of the Calleen Art Award.
- B1.11** Unsuccessful entrants will be notified in writing at the end of the selection process.

B2. FINALISTS AND THEIR SELECTED WORK

- B2.1** A short statement/description from each finalist about the selected work (approx. 70 words) will have to be received by the Gallery within 5 days of being notified of selection.
- B2.2** A selected work must be professionally presented and ready for display with D-rings on the left and right sides attached 6-10 cm from the top of the work and. Cup hooks and wire **must not** be used or attached to a work.
- B2.3** Selected works are to be forwarded with the name of the artist, return address, contact information, title, date and medium attached to the work, and securely

packaged to ensure safe transportation to and from the Gallery. The packaging must be suitable for the Gallery to re-use for the return of the selected artwork.

B3. DELIVERY OF SELECTED ARTWORK

- B3.1** Selected works are to arrive at the Cowra Regional Art Gallery, 77 Darling Street Cowra NSW 2794 up until Friday 8 April 2011 between the hours of 10am and 5pm. Arrangements for delivery outside these hours may be made by contacting the Gallery on (02) 6340 2190. The Gallery is closed for deliveries on weekends, Mondays and public holidays.

B4. TRANSPORTATION

- B4.1** All forward and return transit/freight costs of a selected work is the responsibility of the artist and/or the artist's agent/dealer. A selected artwork will not be received at the Gallery unless free of charge to the Gallery.
- B4.2** All transit /freight insurance arrangements and costs is borne by the artist or the artist's agent/dealer.

B5. INSURANCE AND CARE OF THE ARTWORK

- B5.1** The Cowra Regional Art Gallery, its staff, or agents, and the Cowra Shire Council accepts no liability for the loss or damage of an artwork during transit /freight to and from the Gallery.
- B5.2** The Gallery will exercise all reasonable care of an artwork from time of receipt to the end of the collection date (see section B9.1), however the artist and/or the artist's agent/dealer agrees to indemnify the Cowra Regional Art Gallery, its staff, or agents, and the Cowra Shire Council against the loss or damage to their artwork during this period

B6. SALE OF WORK (COMMISSION AND PAYMENT)

- B6.1** A Gallery commission of 33% applies to all works sold during the finalists exhibition unless ticked NFS (note for sale) on the entry form. The artist's price as listed on the entry form should include the Gallery commission of 33% plus all other commercial gallery fees and/or agent fees and GST (if applicable).
- B6.2** An entered work sold during the finalist exhibition will not be released until the end of the exhibition and payment has been received from the purchaser by the Gallery.
- B6.3** All costs for additional packaging and transit /freight relating to a sold work is the responsibility of the purchaser and/or artist or artist's agent/dealer.

B7. PRIVACY

- B7.1** The information requested on this form is required for the administration of said awards and will only be used for this sole purpose (and where applicable for the ongoing administration of the said awards). This information cannot be accessed by any unauthorised person.

B8. COPYRIGHT AND PROMOTION

- B8.1** Entrants warrant that they are the copyright owner of the artwork submitted with this entry form and he or she agrees to indemnify the Cowra Regional Art Gallery, its staff, or agents, and the Cowra Shire Council for any breach or infringement of copyright.
- B8.2** The Gallery reserves the right to reproduce and/or edit any digital images submitted with the entry form, for archival, catalogue or promotional purposes including electronic and digital promotional activities.
- B8.3** Entrants selected as a finalist agree that their work can be photographed by the Cowra Regional Art Gallery on film and/or a digital format for promotional, educational and review purposes and published in relation to the exhibition, for marketing and web purposes.

B9. RETURN/COLLECTION OF WORKS

- B9.1** A finalist work will be available for collection from the Cowra Regional Art Gallery from **Tuesday 31 May to Friday 3 June 2011** between 10am and 5pm. Arrangements for collection/pick up of a work outside the preferred dates can be made by contacting the Gallery on (02) 6340 2190. The Gallery is closed for the collection of a work on weekends, Mondays and public holidays.
- B9.2** The Cowra Regional Art Gallery accepts no responsibility for the storage of a work 14 days after the exhibition closing date.

B10. INTERPRETATION OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation of the terms and conditions, the decision of the Cowra Regional Art Gallery shall be binding on all parties.

Please Note: Unless the contrary intention appears in the wording of this form, words in the singular number include the plural and words in the plural number include the singular. Also, the word Gallery refers to the Cowra Regional Art gallery and the word work in the context of this entry form refers to a painting/drawing/artwork on paper/collage.
