Welcome to our Autumn Newsletter

During Summer the Gallery presented an exciting and enjoyable program commencing with a multi-layered exhibition of mixed media artworks by Blue Mountains-based artist Adrienne Doig. The exhibition titled *Adrienne Doig: Its All About Me!* was whimsical and colourful exploring the everyday in the artist's life, as well as, universal themes including social, environmental and political narratives. The exhibition was presented in collaboration with the artist and Bathurst Regional Art Gallery.

The second summer exhibition at the Gallery focused on the works of 38 of this country's best political cartoonists. Titled BEHIND THE LINES: Prophecy and Chance the exhibition consisted of 105 selected political cartoons from the 2021 news cycle. The works in this prestigious exhibition from the Museum of Democracy at Old Parliament House provoked, delighted and amused our visitors. Another prestigious and enjoyable exhibition presented during January/ February was *Operation Art* an initiative of the Children's Hospital at Westmead contributing to the wellbeing of sick children and their families by creating work which is uplifting and gives hope to those who spend much of their time at hospital. A Cowra Regional Art Gallery outreach project presented in the Cowra Library.

Images from the Gallery exhibitions and the Young Archie workshops presented during January are opposite.

As mentioned previously the ARCHIBALD PRIZE 2021 – Regional Tour commences at the Art Gallery on the 19 March to 1 May 2022. The Archibald Prize is one of Australia's oldest and most prestigious art awards featuring portraits by some of the most prominent artists in the country.


## Archibald Prize 2021 - Regional Tour
